Although these techniques are damaging, they do adhere to the use of force continuum, the student always chooses how much damage is delivered and when to stop.

This course culminates with scenario based exercises that are designed to allow the student to use techniques learned in a dynamic and intense setting. The information provided during this course is sensitive in nature and will only be offered to 'cleared' students with a legitimate need.

Medium-Light Machinegun Course (2 days) – The Medium and Light Machinegun training gives students the necessary skills to deploy to mission areas where the M240 and M249 weapons will be utilized. They will first learn nomenclature and pertinent information about the weapon system such as, cyclic rate, weight, length, etc. They will then be taken through the proper disassembly and assembly procedure for each weapon system.
